City of Rolling Meadows, Village of Palatine

The project provides rehabilitation of Euclid Avenue, from Roselle Road, extending 1.8 miles east to Plum Grove Road. This includes asphalt milling, pavement patching, longitudinal joint sealing, asphalt overlay, drainage adjustments, removal and replacement of curb and gutter, detector loops and new pavement markings.
